

 The First efficient cause of all true knowledge and all that is known through knowledge is
 Parameshvara.
- 2. ईश्वर सिक्विदानंद स्वरूप, निराकार सर्वशिव्तमान, न्यायकारी, दयालु, अजन्मा, अनंत, निर्विकार, अनादि, अनुपम, सर्वाधार सर्वेश्वर, सर्वध्यापक, सर्वांतर्यामी, अजर, अमर, अनय, नित्य, पवित्र और सृष्टिकर्ता है, उसी की उपासना करने योग्य है। Ishvara is existent, intelligent and blissful. He is formless, omnipotent, omniscient and omnipresent, just, merciful, unborn, endless, unchangeable, unaging, immortal, fearless, eternal, holy and the maker of all. He alone is worth being worshiped.
- वेद सब सत्य विद्याओं का पुस्तक है। येद का पढना-पढ़ाना और सुनना-सुनाना सब आयों का परम धर्म है।
